



# All About Social Work Bingo Instructions

## Host Instructions:

- Decide when to start and select your goal(s)
- Designate a judge to announce events
- Cross off events from the list below when announced

## Goals:

- First to get any line (up, down, left, right, diagonally)
- First to get all four corners
- First to get two diagonal lines through the middle (an "X")
- First to get a "blackout" (all squares)

## Guest Instructions:

- Check off events on your card as they occur
- If you complete a goal, shout "BINGO!". You've won!
- The judge decides in the case of disputes
